Equipment: We will supply a computer, projector, screen, or any basic AV needs you've requested in your proposal submission. Additional AV needs will be at your own expense and must be requested in writing no later than Feb 1st, 2023. No additional AV requests will be honored at the convention site.

Presentation Copy: Please bring a digital copy of the presentation on a flash drive with you as back up.

Hotel Accommodations: As a speaker, you are responsible for your own transportation and convention registration. More information about registration will be provided by email and on the BNRF website.

Shipping: Presenters are responsible for the cost of shipping class displays, teaching aids, samples, etc. to and from the convention site.

Compensation

All accepted speakers will receive a registration discount equivalent to one night of hotel costs.
